## Race Relations Rehabilitation Program

### (RRRP)

Utilizing census data and information available in each jurisdiction, neighborhoods capping over 60 percent minority, require law enforcement officers assigned to those locations to setup town hall meetings for residents within the community. This purpose of these meetings is established names and faces to the members in the community, therefore, humanizing them. The officers have a great opportunity to build trust with their citizens and the citizens also have an opportunity to let down their guard and humanize the officers.

Case workers will provide assistance with those with prior offenses as well as resources for job placement and as well as training. Local businesses who participate in the (RRRP) will receive an incentive to hire reformed convicts who have gone a substantial amount of time without reoffending.

Trade school admission advisor should be present to speak and educate citizens regarding what training is available to them. GED programs should also be available.

Local Businesses are welcomed to attend, to get to other citizens and build relationships within their own community which should cut down on profiling while shopping and people are less likely to loot from stores which they have a connection to.

## Community Elections

Building up one's environment offers a wide range of benefits such as a sense of responsibility and commitment. It is also an initiative to support the fact that the minority vote does matter.

Each jurisdiction is able to vote one qualified candidate into the position of:

**Community Director:** This position is offered to someone with 4yr degree and experience. The duties are as follows: formulating solutions regarding citizen concerns and establishing vendors.

**Manger:** Scheduling follow up events, accounting for each attendee, scheduling interviews with vendors, scheduling community meetings.

**2x Citizen Peace Officers:** The essential duties of the citizen peace officers are to deescalated situations to avoid law enforcement officers being called. The duties also include recounting events and providing crucial information to report directly to law enforcement.

## Race Sensitivity Program and Training

### (RSPT)

Utilizing census data and information available in each jurisdiction, neighborhoods capping over 60 percent white, require law enforcement officers assigned to those locations to setup town hall meetings for resident in the community.

- This training will establish a baseline of what is a threat and what is not a threat by law enforcement officials.
- The hours and the manpower wasted on abusing the 911 system.
- How lives can be affected by both parties.
- Establishing what is appropriate behaviors and what isn't. What constitutes as criminal which would then require law enforcement officers be called.
- How such actions effect race relations in the entire country.

When such incidents occur in the future, callers should be REQUIRED to take this course.

It also should be established by law that bogus and "bomb" threat like hysteria calls can and will result in arrest as well as conviction of a hate crime.
